## **JAY CUSHION CLINICAL CONSIDERATIONS**

This guide is meant to help the therapist differentiate between Jay cushions. It is not a prescriptive tool. Please use this guide along with clinical reasoning to select the most appropriate cushion for an individual client. a = These cushions can be modified at the factory for improved positioning. Possible modifications include: leg length cut, contracture cut, medial support cut, scrotal cut, and increased lateral support.

**b** = In addition to a contoured foam base for positioning, these cushions can have positioning pieces added for off-the-shelf customization in the field. Positioning pieces include: lateral pelvic support/hip guides, medial thigh support, lateral thigh support. The closed cell foam base for these cushions can be carved in the field to accommodate fixed deformities (e.g. leg length discrepancy, hip contracture trough). These modifications can also be done at the factory level.

c = Customization of the fluid can be requested at the factory level (e.g. overfill/underfill; obliquity overfill/underfill).

d = Supplemental fluid pads can be used with the field variable PLA insert for off-the-shelf customization in the field.
